Sushi Garage's Happiest Hour is available everyday at its three locations from 5:30-8 p.m. and is always offered on its cozy outdoor patios, where diners can feast on favorites such as the Korean beef leaf taco (\$5), fried tofu with black garlic honey (\$7), sashimi or sushi (\$3-\$5.50) and chili shrimp dumplings (\$7). Guests can also take advantage of the drink specials with sake starting at \$11.50, beers starting at \$3, wines starting at \$4.50, and all specialty cocktails at \$5.
