Miami Beach Classical Music Festival Returns With Immersive Concert Series

Following last year's resounding success, the Miami Beach Classical Music Festival makes its return with a citywide summer series running May 31 through Aug. 31. Highlights include the Miami Beach Pride Concert on Ocean Drive from May 31 to June 1, the annual Fourth of July Patriotic Concert and Fireworks at Lummus Park, and the debut of Immersive Galactic Symphony at Temple Emanu-El from July 26 through Aug. 31. In a major milestone for the city's arts scene, MMF will also unveil Miami Beach's first permanent immersive theater, transforming the grand ballroom of Temple Emanu-El into a 360-degree projection-mapped venue for classical performances and cultural events.
